AMENDMENT "1"

WAIVER RULES AND REGULATIONS, AVIATION FUELING
ARTICLE 8, SECTION (d) (1) FUEL HANDLING

August 5, 2013

In accordance with the request of Mr. Chuck Lawson, Director of Operations Jacksonville JetPort (JJP), the JAA recognizes the operational need for rapid fueling by certain military units at Cecil Airport. As the sole Fixed Based Operator (FBO) and only authorized contract fuel provider for military aircraft at Cecil Airport the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) has no objection to the rapid fuel (Hot Refueling) operations of military aircraft.

This decision is based on the condition that each military unit requesting this service conducts an inspection of JJP fueling operation. This inspection will conclude with a pre-certification understanding between the military unity and JJP prior to operations. This inspection should measure JJP's skills and abilities to perform rapid fueling operations safety and to their standard.

All rapid fuel operations shall be conducted in the designated area. Use of other areas may be acquired with written JAA consent. As authorized by the Rules and Regulations, this written notice waives the statement in the JAA Rules and Regulations, Article 8, section (d) (1) that rapid fuel (Hot Refueling) operations are allowed only for Helicopters, and authorizes for other military aircraft. All other elements of Article 8 apply.

This waiver and non objection will be made a part of the Rules and Regulations for future reference.
