WHEREAS, the Parties also desire to correct a scrivener's error regarding Concessionaire's company name / corporate type in the introductory paragraph.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES, BASED UPON MUTUAL CONSIDERATION, THE SUFFICIENCY OF WHICH IS ACKNOWLEDGED, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Article 7, Section 7.1 Titled "Gross Revenues" is hereby modified to add the following subsection 7.1 (h.) which explicitly excludes CFC's from Gross Revenues.
