Drone Operations at JAA GA Airports

There two options to legally fly a drone.

- Hobbyists (Fly for hobby or recreation only)
- Part 107 (Small UAS Rule recreation or commercial use)

Cecil and JaxEx

a.) Hobbyists:

- Must notify the JAA and Air Traffic Control tower prior to flying within 5 miles of an airport.

- Must maintain visual line of sight with the drone
- Never fly near other aircraft.
- Never fly near emergency response efforts.

B. Part 107 Operators:

- Receive a Remote Pilot Certificate from the FAA and waiver to fly in controlled airspace.
- Must notify the JAA and Air Traffic Control tower prior to flying within 5 miles of the airport.

- Fly within visual line of sight.
- Don't fly near other aircraft or over people.
- Fly only during daylight or civil twilight.
- Fly at or below 400 feet.
- * Each rule is subject to waiver by the FAA. The operator must submit a waiver to FAA for review.

Herlong:

a.) Hobbyists:

- Must notify the JAA prior to flying within 5 miles of an airport.
- Notify JAA at Herlong via the web: http://www.flyjacksonville.com/content2015.aspx?id=1082
- Must maintain visual line of sight with the drone
- Never fly near other aircraft.
- Never fly near emergency response efforts.

B. Part 107 Operators:

- Receive a Remote Pilot Certificate from the FAA.
- Must enter into an LOA or Permit with JAA and meet minimum standards.

- Operate within the HEG Drone operations area in accordance to LOA provisions and Part 107.
