Questions and Answers**

- Q1. What are the hours of operations for the timber cleanup project?
- R1. Monday-Friday, dawn to dusk.**
- Q2. What is the percentage deduction for the Local Preference Program?
- R2. 5%. A copy of JAA's Local Preference Program Standard Practice is attached.**
- Q3. If a Bidder is not located in the normal market area but sub-contracts with a local company in the normal market area, will the Bidder be eligible for Local Preference Program consideration?
- R3. No.**
- Q4. Scope of Services, Bid Method #1 states: Rake/windrow all felled trees, limbs and debris along forest line to the east of the harvested area. The site map shows a road near the area, can the Bidder leave the felled trees, limbs and debris in that area?
- R4. No. Debris cannot be left on the road.**
- Q5. Please clarify if any of the first three (3) bid items are to include removal of existing stumps.
- R5. No.**
- Q6. Please clarify the meaning of bid item three (3): Slash/grind/mulch/scatter all felled trees, limbs and debris.
- R6. Any debris that is left from the clear cut, excluding stumps. Felled trees, limbs or other associated clear-cut debris would be mulched and the mulch left on the ground.**
