The following **ADDITION** is being made:

1.09 MANDATORY RESPONDENT CRITERIA

- D. Respondent and/or Subcontractor shall be certified on C-Cure software, I-Star controllers by Software House to work on the access control system. A copy of certification shall be submitted with bid.

All other requirements in Article 1.09 remain as is.

The following **CHANGES** are being made:

1.01 RECEIPT AND OPENING OF BIDS

JAA will receive Bids in response to this solicitation until **May 28, 2013** at 2:00 PM (local time) for the purpose of selecting a company to provide Security Access Rehabilitation Services at Cecil Airport, Building 82 (the "Scope of Services"). Bids will be publicly opened at JAA's Administration Building, 14201 Pecan Park Road, Jacksonville, Florida, at the previously mentioned time and date.

This project has been deemed a JAA Small Business Enterprise (SBE) project. Only firms certified as JAA SBE and the City of Jacksonville certified Small Emerging Business (JSEB) may participate as Bidders for this project.

1.19 EVALUATION AND AWARD

JAA reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Bids, in whole or in part. JAA reserves the right to award the ITB to the Respondent submitting a bid which is most advantageous and in the best interests of JAA. Tie bids will be awarded pursuant to JAA's Local Preference Program and if after its application the tie remains, preference will be given to the Respondent that certifies it has implemented a drug-free workforce program. If a tie still remains, JAA will award the ITB in the manner determined to be in the best interests of JAA. JAA will be the sole judge of the bids and the resulting award that is in its best interest and its decision will be final. JAA Executive Director/CEO has final approval authority for any resulting agreement. This ITB is subject to the availability of budgeted funds.

Within ten (10) days after notice of award is made, the successful Respondent will be given a JAA purchase order and Respondent must acknowledge receipt. Award will not be binding until this purchase order has been received and acknowledged by the Respondent to contain the terms of the contract. Respondent terms different from JAA's (on JAA purchase order or contained in the Contract) will not be allowed.



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2.06 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE RESPONDENT

- I **The Contractor must have a supervisor on site anytime work is being performed.** All employees/subcontractors/independent operators of the Contractor assigned to Cecil Airport must obtain a Security Badge. The initial badge is issued at no cost to the Contractor. **The Contractor is responsible for all costs associated with replacement badges, which at a minimum is \$50 per badge.** JAA does not guarantee that the initial badge will remain at no cost to the Contractor throughout the duration of the contract. A secondary supervisor may be assigned to be on site as a back up. A security badge is required for the secondary supervisor.

All secure access will be under escort of JAA. Building security shall be maintained at all times either by mechanical means of access restriction or guarded by contractor employee.

All other requirements in Article 2.06 remain as is.

- Q1.** Will JAA take into consideration the lead-time on the doors that have to be ordered so that it is not included in the 60 days for project completion?
- R1.** Yes, consideration will be given for the lead-time on the doors.
