BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) has a continuous need to have appropriate levels of spare parts on-hand to support the TIBA parking system's on-going maintenance program. Much of the initial capital spare parts have been used and thus there is a need to procure additional spare parts in a timely manner.

Pursuant to Section 3.08 of JAA's Procurement Code, Procurement has reviewed a competitively awarded contract with favorable pricing from Sourcewell. As such, Procurement is of the opinion that it is in JAA's best interest to piggy-back Sourcewell Contract No. 070121-JHN awarded to Johnson Controls for parts related to the TIBA parking system.

The initial quote for spare parts is \$30,321.00. In addition, Procurement recommends an additional \$105,000.00 for as needed inventory spare parts through the piggy-backed contract expiration of August 12, 2025.

RECOMMENDATION:

Procurement recommends JAA utilize Sourcewell Contract No. 070121-JHN, pursuant to Section 3.08 of the Procurement Code, to make a properly noticed award to Johnson Controls, Inc. for: (i) TIBA spare parts in the amount of \$30,321.00; and (ii) future as-needed spare parts for TIBA, CCTV and Access Control systems in the amount of \$105,000.00, for total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$135,321.00, through the contract expiration of August 12, 2025. JAA reserves the right to make similar purchases from other vendors when it is in its best interest to do so. Funding is budgeted primarily within the Information Technologies Dept, cost center 24001.77420 and various cost centers.

BACKGROUND:

The Marketing Department is tasked with coordinating multiple events across all four airports on various dates throughout the year, including inaugural events, ribbon cuttings, groundbreakings, non-aeronautical promotional events, holiday décor, special musical programs, gallery openings and similar events.

Due to an expiring contract, on April 17, 2023, Procurement released Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 23-05-44202 for Event Planning and Production Services, and on May 16, 2023, received one conforming proposal from PRI Productions. The sole conforming proposal was reviewed and evaluated on May 24, 2023. The Evaluation Committee unanimously recommended that the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) negotiate with and issue an award to PRI Productions.

The contract will be for an initial three-year term with renewals of up to two years available at the sole option of JAA. This contract can be used for a variety of special events during it life.

RECOMMENDATION:

Marketing recommends that JAA make a requirements award to PRI Productions, the sole responsible and responsive respondent to RFQ No. 23-05-44202, in a total five-year potential not-to-exceed amount of \$525,000, for event planning and production services, with an initial three-year term and renewal options of up to two years at JAA's sole discretion, based on the vendor's performance, adherence to contract terms and conditions and approved budgeted funds.

BACKGROUND:

On August 22, 2022, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved JAA Award No. AC20222-08-02 to make a formal piggy-back contract award to Interface Services, Inc., in a total not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000.00 for JIA Flooring Replacement throughout the terminal and concourses of the Jacksonville International Airport (JIA) due to excessive wear and stains from high passenger traffic.

As a result of the record levels of passenger traffic and the increase of passengers consuming food in the carpeted area due to the loss of dining seating areas, the carpet replacement frequency has increased. Engineering & Facilities is requesting authorization to increase the total award to replace the carpet in high traffic areas of the Terminal on an as-needed basis, as well as the CEO's office in the Administration Building.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends JAA Award No. AC2022-08-02, awarded to Interface Services, Inc., for JIA Flooring Replacement, be amended to increase the amount by \$9,554.05 to replace the carpet in the CEO's office. It is also recommended that the award amount be increased by an additional \$90,482.55 to cover future carpet replacement and installation projects, resulting in a new potential not-to-exceed award total of \$200,036.60. JAA reserves the right to make similar purchases from other vendors when it is in its best interest to do so. Funds are budgeted in cost center 45123.77420.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) wishes to engage Presidio Networked Solutions, LLC on a time and materials basis to provide a complete wireless architecture assessment. JAA currently offers free wireless internet access (a.k.a. JAX-Free-WIFI) in the JIA terminal. The current architecture was designed and deployed in 2016; however, customer service survey results highlight a consistent decline over the years in passenger satisfaction of the strength, quality, and connectivity of this internet access. The rapid increase of mobile devices and applications has increased the usage of JAX-Free-WIFI, the preferred method of network access, making this service a critical offering for our passengers. Initial investigations indicate radio interference in some areas, as well as other potential technical issues causing disruptions and/or quality of signal.

To get a comprehensive understanding of issues affecting JAX-Free-WIFI service, a study needs to be conducted to identify sources of interference, usage patterns, and other technical remediations necessary to optimize the system for the traveling public. Procurement and IT have reviewed this piggyback option pursuant to §3.08 of JAA's Procurement Code, it is in JAA's best interest to utilize the pricing and related terms of NASPO Contract No. 43230000-NASPO-16-ACS, Cloud Solutions, which was competitively awarded to Presidio Networked Solutions, LLC.

RECOMMENDATION:

Information Technology recommends JAA utilize NASPO Contract No. 43230000-NASPO-16-ACS to make a properly noticed award to Presidio Networked Solutions, LLC, pursuant to Section 3.08 of JAA's Procurement Code, for the analysis of the public-facing wireless internet infrastructure and related services, in a potential amount of \$38,022.00, with an additional contingency amount of \$1,901.10 to cover any unforeseen costs or changes during the project. This will result in the total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$39,923.10. Funding for this purchase is budgeted within cost center 24001.77410.

BACKGROUND:

On May 23, 2022, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved Awards No. AC2022-05-13SR for the standardization of TAMCO LED lighting fixtures. Engineering & Facilities has utilized these fixtures for Passenger Loading Bridges, Daily and Hourly Parking Garages and related installations on an "as-needed" basis. Funds approved via JAA Awards No. AC2022-06-10 - awarded to City Electric Supply - have been exhausted and requires an amendment to continue the TAMCO LED Light Kits retrofit for the Daily Surface Lot, Economy Lot 1 and both Parking Garages.

The Engineering & Facilities Department requests authorization to purchase additional TAMCO LED retrofit lights for Economy Lot 1, Daily Surface Lot and both Parking Garages. These additional kits will allow the completion of the LED upgrades and will provide inventory to replace the burned-out lights in both Parking Garages.

RECOMMENDATION:

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

BACKGROUND:

This project includes approximately 47,000 linear feet of crack repair varying in width from 1/8" to 1" at JaxEx and Herlong Airports. There is also one 500-square-foot area of asphalt pavement repair at Herlong, and repainting of the repair areas.

Runways 5-23 at JaxEx and Runway 7-25 at Herlong were last rehabilitated in 2011 and 2010, respectively, making the pavements 12 and 13 years old. It is typical for asphalt pavements to need significant maintenance such as crack repair at about 10 years old. This is due primarily to environmental factors, such as weathering, oxidation, etc., and does not indicate that the pavement is losing its ability to support the loads for which it was designed. Performing maintenance now will prolong the life of the pavement and delay the need for complete rehabilitation.

In response to ITB C-875, two responsive bids were received on May 30, 2023.

FedEx Roof Rehabilitation

Hi-Lite Airfield Services, LLC	\$ 137,897.00
JD Hinson Company	\$ 564,011.20

There is a very wide gap (approximately 400 percent) between the two bids. Hi-Lite's bid is approximately 24 percent below the Engineer's estimate of \$170,556.00, while Hinson's is approximately 330 percent above. Based on a comparison of unit prices and total price with the Engineer's estimate, Hi-Lite's bid appears to be more appropriate for the required scope of work. Discussions with the low bidder indicate that they have reviewed the project requirements and are comfortable with their bid. There are currently \$248,775.00 remaining in the project budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends JAA make an award to Hi-Lite Airfield Services, LLC, the lower of two responsive, responsible bidders in response to ITB C-875, for the Crack Repair Projects of Runway 5-23 at CRG and Runway 7-25 at HEG, in the amount of \$137,897.00.

BACKGROUND:

On May 22, 2023, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee previously approved JAA Award No. AC2023-05-13 for the construction of a new Employee Parking Lot at Jacksonville International Airport (JIA). The parking lot construction was awarded to JD Hinson Company in the amount of \$9,749,869.17.

One item that was not included in JD Hinson's scope of services was furnishing, installing, and programming security cameras and parking revenue control equipment. BACKGROUND:

At the May meeting of the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) Awards Committee, Item AC2023-05-14 was approved for the JIA Airfield Wetland Mitigation at Jacksonville International Airport. This project will reduce wildlife attractants through filling and regrading approximately 69 acres of wetlands. BACKGROUND:

This project includes the extension of the Approach Road and Utility Corridor on the east side of Cecil Airport. The proposed construction begins approximately 2,300 feet south of 103rd Street and continues south approximately 8,100 feet to the Spaceport Development Area. The first 3,900 feet of the project consists of a reconstruction of the existing approach road to include a 24-foot-wide roadway, stormwater ditching, erosion control, landscaping, irrigation, and sidewalk. Utilities in this area were previously installed in 2018 from 103rd Street to the existing maintenance facility / pump station.

The remaining 4,200 feet of 24-foot-wide roadway will consist of new construction within a proposed 85-foot-wide Right-of-Way (ROW), stormwater infrastructure, ditching, erosion control, and the extension of the utility corridor down to the Spaceport Development Area. The utility corridor extension includes a 16" watermain, 4" force main, 10" gravity sewer, underground electrical and installation of a new pump station.

In response to ITB C-871, three responsive bids were received on May 23, 2023.

The lowest bid submitted by JB Coxwell is approximately 4.9 percent below the Engineer's estimate of \$21,020,815.00. A review of the unit prices indicates that they are generally consistent with the work to be performed. There are currently \$21,026,665.02 remaining in the project budget.
