BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) current contractual relationship with Foley & Lardner, LLP (Foley) for bond counsel services resulted from: (i) Request for Proposals No. 16-03-31001; (ii) Office of General Counsel (OGC) approval; and (iii) subsequent Board approval pursuant to JAA Board Submission No. BD2016-09-02, all in accordance with Section 126.310, Jacksonville Ordinance Code (Foley Contract). The duration of JAA's Foley Contract has been amended through March 31, 2024. The Foley Contract was used to secure financing for JAA's current Terminal Expansion Project through bond counsel services provided by Foley attorneys, Chauncey Lever and Emily Magee. Mr. Lever has since retired, and Ms. Magee is currently employed by the law firm of Butler Snow, LLP.

For purposes of bond counsel continuity throughout the financing and completion of its Terminal Expansion Project, both Foley and OGC have agreed that it is in JAA best interest to retain and continue its legal relationship with Ms. Magee through her new law firm, Butler Snow, LLP. Please note that, for bond counsel services unrelated to its Terminal Expansion Project, JAA will solicit proposals and return to the Awards Committee for a separate award.

In addition to the above, JAA's Awards Committee approved JAA Award No. AC2023-01-06 which permits JAA to engage in legal relationships with additional law firms as the need arises. For purposes of clarity, it is requested to JAA Award No. AC2023-01-06 be amended to specifically name the law firm of Butler Snow, LLP, as one of JAA's legal service providers.

RECOMMENDATION:

Management recommends JAA issue a properly noticed award to Butler Snow, LLP, pursuant to Section 3.09 of the Procurement Code, in an estimated amount of \$200,000.00, for purposes of bond counsel continuity for legal services specifically associated with financing JAA's Terminal Expansion Project (Project), with a duration lasting until the Project financing process is complete. Legal fees and costs resulting from this award are considered Project closing costs. It is also recommended that JAA Award No. AC2023-01-06 for legal services be amended to specifically name the law firm of Butler Snow, LLP.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) is responsible for the maintenance and repair of the elevators, escalators and moving walkways located at the Jacksonville International Airport (JIA) and the elevators located at Cecil Airport (Cecil). A maintenance contract has been in place to ensure this equipment is properly maintained and in compliance with all applicable regulations and inspections.

On November 6, 2023, Procurement issued Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 24-01-45123 for elevator, escalator and moving walkway maintenance and repair services. On December 7, 2023, Procurement received the following three Proposals:

After review and scoring of the proposals submitted, the evaluation committee unanimously recommended that a contract award be made to Otis Elevator Company.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends an award be made to Otis Elevator Company, the top ranked and most responsive of three proposers for RFP No. 24-01-45123, for elevator, escalator and moving walkway maintenance and repair services, for an initial three-year term in a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,628,694.12 with renewals of up to two years, in a potential total five-year not-to-exceed amount of \$2,797,553.64. Based upon historical spend data, it is also recommended that an annual repair contingency of \$100,000.00 be included as part of this award. Funding is budgeted within 45123 and 44202.

As a result of ongoing services and repairs, the funds approved on the above-referenced awards are approaching depletion. Therefore, an amendment in the amount of \$79,501.20 is needed for month-to-month maintenance through February 2024 and to close out the contract.

RECOMMENDATION:

Procurement recommends that JAA Award No. AC2018-06-01S, awarded to Otis Elevator Company *dba* Coastal Elevator Company, for elevator, escalator and moving walkways maintenance and repairs, be further amended to increase the contract award by \$79,501.20 to cover additional month-to-month maintenance services through February 2024 and contract close out, for a final total not-to-exceed amount of \$7,975,281.60.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) made an informal award to Sawyer Gas / Amerigas Propane LP to provide as-needed propane gas to support the Fire Station at the Jacksonville International Airport and various generators at all airport locations. Such purchases are exempt from competition under Section 2.05(A)(4) of the Procurement Code.

Due to on-going needs for propane gas by all airport locations, the approved spending authority is approaching depletion. Therefore, this award is a request to increase funding for propane gas enterprise-wide in the amount of \$25,265.90.

RECOMMENDATION:

Procurement recommends JAA's informal award to Sawyer Gas / Amerigas Propane LP for propane gas, be amended to increase the not-to-exceed amount by an additional \$25,265.90, for use on an "as-needed" basis through September 30, 2026, resulting in a new potential not-to-exceed award total of \$50,264.90. This award has been properly publicly noticed and is exempt from competition pursuant to Section 2.05(A)(4) of JAA's Procurement Code. JAA reserves the right to make similar purchases from other vendors when it is in its best interest to do so. Funds are budgeted within various cost centers.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Public Safety and Security Division (PSS) requires new and replacement uniforms and accessories for all officers. Officers must be issued new uniforms to replace worn uniforms, based on specifications and JAA logo illustrations to maintain a uniform appearance in accordance with work requirements.

The previous uniform award with Patrick's Uniform expired on June 30, 2023, and after Procurement and PSS review, an alternative vendor, GT Distributors, has been utilized informally. PSS has been pleased with the customer service and lower pricing available from GT Distributors.

Pursuant to Section 2.05(A)(12) and/or 3.08 of the Procurement Code, Procurement has reviewed BuyBoard Contract No. 698-23 which offers current and favorable pricing on the brands and items that are required for PSS. As such, Procurement is of the opinion that it is in JAA's best interest to piggyback the contract which was competitively awarded to GT Distributors. Based on historic spend for a full staff, PSS requests \$100,000.00 to be utilized through the contract expiration date of March 31, 2026.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Public Safety and Security Department recommends JAA make a properly noticed, non-exclusive award to GT Distributors, Inc., utilizing BuyBoard Contract No. 698-23, pursuant to Sections 2.05(A)(12) and/or 3.08 of the Procurement Code, in a potential total not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000.00, over a contract term ending March 31, 2026.

BACKGROUND:

In 2009, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) began a partnership with the PGA Tour, Inc. This partnership: (i) centers around the annual preeminent golf tournament event held here in NE Florida, originally referred to as "THE PLAYERS Championship", then "TPC", now currently "THE PLAYERS," which brings golfing professionals and their entourages, together with thousands of fans, from across the world to Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida; and (ii) complies with FAA Airport Compliance Manual, FAA Order No. 5190.6B, § 15.9(b), designed to promote public awareness of the JAA's facilities and services.

JAA has again agreed to be a sponsor for the 2024 event at a cost of \$30,000.00. Further, JAA has committed to provide sponsorship for a total of three years: 2024-2026, FY24 - \$30,000.00; FY25 - \$31,500.00; and FY26 - \$33,000.00. Therefore, a total of \$94,500.00 is being requested.

RECOMMENDATION:

Executive Management recommends JAA make a properly noticed award, pursuant to §2.05(A)(7) of the Procurement Code, to PGA Tour, Inc. for a three-year sponsorship of the current tournament, THE PLAYERS, in the amounts of \$30,000.00 for FY2024, \$31,500.00 for FY2025 and \$33,000.00 for FY2026, for a potential total not-to-exceed amount of \$94,500.00.

BACKGROUND:

In June 2022, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) approved JAA Award No. AC2022-06-11 to Sourcewell to aid Procurement in procuring small construction contractors. Sourcewell, a governmental organization dedicated to helping public agencies through large scale cooperative purchasing initiatives, competitively solicited, and issued Contract Award No. 091620-GGI to Gordian in 2020 with a maturity date of October 1, 2025.

In November 2022, JAA Award No. AC2022-11-10 was also approved to add funding for continued contract utilization for the fabrication and installation of 24 canopies to cover the entrance and exit points of all parking facilities and other small construction projects "as-needed."

Currently, three projects are actively progressing in various stages; however only \$98,398.30 in approved funding remains, requiring additional funds to initiate purchase orders to bring projects to completion. This request is to provide funding for the price proposal reference in Exhibit C and one remaining pricing proposal for repairs to a Herlong Hangar.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities and Procurement recommend JAA Award No. AC2022-06-11, which was awarded to Gordian and the various authorized contractors approved thereunder for enterprise-wide small construction work, be further amended to increase the available funds for use under this contract by an additional \$400,000.00, for a new total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$1,100,000.00. Funding for this purchase is budgeted within the requesting departments' cost centers and will be verified and approved via JAA's requisition process.

BACKGROUND:

On September 20, 2021, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved JAA Award No. AC2021-09-20 to the City of Jacksonville (COJ) for use of its First Coast Radio System, for JAA's Police and Operations communications with other COJ agencies such as Jacksonville Fire and Rescue and the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office. The award authorized funding for services for two years in a total not-to-exceed amount of \$86,877.60. The authorized funding is reaching depletion and requires approval to increase spending authority.

COJ calculates a per radio rate each year, and the rate varies based on anticipated system costs and upgrades. The expected rate for FY24 is \$28.31. JAA maintains 106 radios, so the extended annual cost at this rate is \$36,010.32, which will cover the contract period of October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2024.

It should be noted that changing the quantity of radios on the system, or changes to future rates will affect the amount JAA is required to pay.

Additionally, Information Technology would like to request a contingency amount to cover 10 additional radios for the contract period.

RECOMMENDATION:

Information Technology recommends JAA Award No. AC2021-09-20, awarded to the City of Jacksonville (COJ) for use of its First Coast Radio System, be amended, pursuant to Section 3.09 of the Procurement Code, to: (i) extend the use of services with the COJ through FY24; and (ii) increase the funding by \$39,407.52, for a new total potential not-to-exceed award amount of \$126,285.12. Funds for these services are available within 24001 cost center.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) has had increasing cyber-security requirements from various sources, such as the TSA Emergency Amendment, Payment Card Industry, Florida Department of Law Enforcement, and Florida House Bill 7055. In addition, there is movement towards regulatory requirements from Federal Aviation Administration related to Spaceport.

Meeting these regulatory requirements requires matching detailed requirements, which may be hundreds of items, with how JAA meets those requirements, and then matching to evidence supporting compliance. This has become an increasingly difficult task and has been highly manual and subject to human error. To help ensure that compliance items are not missed JAA's Information Technology Department (JAA IT) recommends a solution to track these requirements and associate them to proof documentation.
