### Additional Information

On 05.16.25 at 1206p, AOCC received a forwarded dispatch from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office regarding a vehicle on fire in the hourly garage. JAAPD Officers responded to the scene.

JAAPD Officer J. Muse #570 was first to arrive on scene on the upper level (departures). Officer Muse observed a vehicle on fire rapidly spreading to neighboring vehicles. Due to low/no visibility Officer Muse assisted several passengers from the hourly

Jacksonville Fire/Rescue responded, extinguished the fire, and treated unknown passengers for smoke inhalation. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office dispatched officers for additional assistance. The Jacksonville International Airport ceased all

According to the initial assessment there is structural damage resulting in no access/closure of the hourly garage. It has not been determined how many vehicles were damaged at this time.
