BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Public Safety and Security Division requires new and replacement uniforms and accessories for all officers. Officers must be issued new uniforms to replace worn uniforms, based on specifications and JAA logo illustrations to maintain a uniform appearance per work requirements. Officers must have a local retail location in which to obtain proper fittings and uniforms specific to JAA's brand.

In an effort to re-evaluate the local market for competitive solicitations, JAA found Duval County Public Schools (DCPS) released ITB-030-20/LN in 2020 for athletic clothing, equipment and supplies. The contract had multiple awardees, with only two local vendors capable of custom fittings, and only one that specializes in police uniforms.

Pursuant to § 3.08 of the Procurement Code, Procurement has reviewed DCPS Contract ITB-030-20/LN which offers current and favorable pricing and is of the opinion that it is in JAA's best interest to purchase the requested uniforms and accessories by utilizing or piggy-backing DCPS Contract ITB-030-20/LN, which was competitively awarded to Patrick's Uniforms of Florida, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION:

JAA's Public Safety and Security Department recommends that JAA utilize DCPS Contract No. ITB-030-20/LN, to make a properly noticed non-exclusive award to Patrick's Uniforms of Florida, Inc., for uniforms and related supplies in a not-to-exceed annual amount of \$33,000.00 (based on historical spend). The referenced contract has a current term of July 21, 2020 through June 30, 2021, with two annual renewals available. BACKGROUND:

In 2019, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Engineering and Facilities Department discovered the asphalt road exit at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel located at Jacksonville International Airport (JIA) requires repairs to correct poor drainage and inadequate grading that results in rainwater accumulation, as well as cracking and water penetration into the asphalt. All drains have been cleaned out and associated ditches were graded properly to support sufficient drainage. Approximately 6,400 square feet of asphalt and/or limerock is required to be replaced and regraded to support water flowing to the existing drains.

BACKGROUND:

JAA utilizes a forestry consultant to manage timber on airport properties, the current contract for which ended April 14, 2021. As such, JAA issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to provide timber management and forestry on-call support for three of its four airports (JAX, JaxEx, and Herlong). These services include, but are not limited to, updating the current Timber Management Plan and coordinating forestry activities with the St. John's River Water Management District, Army Corps of Engineers, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and the City of Jacksonville.

Only one proposal was received in response to this solicitation and, inasmuch as JAA considers re-solicitation unnecessary under the circumstances, the proposal was evaluated, scored and found to meet all criteria set forth in the RFP. As such, the evaluation committee unanimously recommended beginning negotiations with the sole proposer, which resulted in the potential payment summary attached as Exhibit "C".

RECOMMENDATION:

Planning and Engineering recommends that JAA make an award to The Forestry Company (TFC), the sole respondent to RFP No. 21-11-42001, for forestry management, on-call forestry support, and related services, in an initial three-year term, with renewals of up to two years. This contract is revenue generating, minus payments to TFC made from the gross receipts hereof.

BACKGROUND:

This award submission is contingent upon the approval of Award No. AC2021-06-05SR and requests the conversion of current fluorescent lighting fixtures to indoor LED in all 18 columns located throughout the JIA Courtyard area. More specifically, the desired scope of work for this project includes: (i) removal of all existing fixtures; (ii) installation of 288 LED strip kits, complete with a 7-year non-pro-rated warranty; (iii) installation of three dimmers that will be connected to Metasys, the terminal building automation system; and (iv) installation of two 120-Volt circuits from the existing electrical panel to six of the 18 columns. This proposed conversion from fluorescent to indoor LED lighting will reduce energy consumption by an anticipated 20 percent. Additionally, LED bulbs last up to 13 times longer than the current fluorescent bulbs, offering significant maintenance and parts cost savings. This project is critical to facilities' integration of lighting systems into Metasys, enabling sustainability and energy savings.

BACKGROUND:

Cecil Airport has an operational need for emergency "ring down" communications, to enable rapid response to aircraft emergencies.

The current system is a simple ring-down line supplied by AT&T, that is connected to the tower and fire house at Cecil Airport. However, expanding this system to the new firehouse and adding other, additional ring-down locations is difficult and expensive. In addition, the current arrangement does not provide desired audit logs when the system is in use, and also does not provide system monitoring to alert JAA personnel if there is a system problem.

Kova, Corp. provides an emergency notification system (KEANS – Kova Emergency Alert Notification System) that includes logging, system monitoring, and redundancy for approximately the same annual cost as the current solution, with cost savings estimated within Year-2 and beyond.

Note that the KOVA, Corp. quote is \$38,700.00. However, the cost depends on the type and quantity of end points that are selected for actual use. Information Technology recommends an award in an amount of 15%, or \$5,805, above the quote for a total potential award amount of \$44,505.00 to provide some flexibility to modify end point selection during deployment. Also note that there will be system support and maintenance costs in the Year-2 and beyond. A separate award request for will be forthcoming for this recurring annual cost.

RECOMMENDATION:

Information Technology recommends that JAA utilize GSA Contract No. GS-35F-011BA, to make a properly noticed non-exclusive award to KOVA Corporation, for Cecil Airport's KEANS emergency communications system in the not-to-exceed amount of \$44,505.00. Funds are budgeted in cost center 24001.
