BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to JAA Award No. AC2020-05-06, JAA made an award to Pond & Company (Pond) and The Haskell Company (Haskell) on the Cecil Airport Eastside Development and/or Boeing Maintenance Facility Project, for architectural / engineering design services and construction manager at risk services, respectively. To mitigate the continued escalation in steel prices, Pond issued an early procurement package for structural steel based upon 60% construction documents, rather than waiting for the 100% construction documents. Haskell distributed the early steel package to several steel mills and/or fabricators and, as indicated below, three bids were received:

In addition to the cost of the steel, Haskell incurred certain design, detailing and administrative costs necessary to fully develop and release the early steel package. These costs also include taxes, bonds, insurance and allowable mark-ups, all of which total an additional \$2,214,264.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends the portion of JAA Award No. AC2020-05-06 made to The Haskell Company (Haskell), for construction manager at risk services on the Cecil Airport Eastside Development / Boeing Maintenance Facility Project (Project), be amended to authorize Haskell to procure the structural steel for the Project from Chatham Steel Corporation, for a guaranteed maximum price of \$10,135,803.63 in an effort to mitigate the continued escalation in steel prices. Due to frequent price increases from the steel mills/fabricators, it is also recommended that a contingency of \$300,000 (or approximately 3 percent) be included in the award for a potential maximum cost of \$10,435,803.63.

BACKGROUND:

JAA's current security guard services contract will expire on November 2, 2021. Therefore, on May 10, 2021, Procurement released Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 21-22-46104, Security Guard Services, seeking proposals from firms with State of Florida Class "B" Security Agency Licensing. On June 17, 2021, JAA received bids from the following four companies: (i) Sanders Sentinel Security; (ii) DSI Security Services; (iii) Allied Universal; and (iv) Giddens Security Corporation. Sanders Sentinel Security was deemed nonconforming for failure to provide written documentation for Mandatory Respondent Criteria.

On July 28, 2021, three proposals were received, reviewed, evaluated, and scored, based on criteria with a maximum of 105 points. The results were as follows:

BACKGROUND:

On May 14, 2021, Procurement released Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 21-25-45133, Fencing Installation and Repair Services, seeking pricing for two fencing projects and itemized unit pricing for future fencing installation and repair services. On June 15, 2021, JAA received bids from the following two companies: (i) RFE Construction & Fence Services, Inc.; and (ii) The Goodly Group of Northeast Florida, Inc. The bids were reviewed, and RFE Construction & Fence Services, Inc.; was the lower, responsive, responsible, bidder.

The two fencing projects totaled \$16,004.00 and, therefore, were under JAA's formal threshold. Since JAA obtained itemized pricing for future fencing installation and repair services on a "as-needed" basis, a formal request for approved funds is being made for the same.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) recent Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) inspection for compliance with Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 139, Certification of Airports, revealed multiple findings that require immediate action. These findings included changes in airfield markings identified in various advisory circulars, including without limitation removing and relocating various airfield markings.

The current contract for Runway Paint and Removal Services is on a month-to-month term pending re-solicitation. During research and review, it was discovered that the Statewide Airfield Pavement Management Program lists a new contract available to over 100 public airports in the state of Florida. Upon review of the executed contract and pursuant to Sections 2.05(A)(12) and 3.08 of JAA's Procurement Code, FDOT Contract No. BEA97 / DOT-RFP-21-9019-CA was deemed the most favorable and efficient method to procure airfield assessments, markings, and related services. As such, Procurement is of the opinion that it is in JAA's best interest to procure these services by utilizing or piggy-backing this FDOT contract, which was competitively awarded to Florida Airfield Maintenance, JV.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends JAA utilize FDOT Contract No. BEA97 / DOT-RFP-21-9019-CA, to make a properly noticed award to Florida Airfield Maintenance, JV, pursuant to Sections 2.05(A)(12) and 3.08 of JAA's Procurement Code, for Airport Pavement Marking Condition Assessments, Markings, and Related Services, in a not-to-exceed amount of \$600,000.00, for use on an "asneeded" basis for the duration of the utilized contract, which is from March 19, 2021 through December 31, 2023, with three additional annual renewals based upon satisfactory performance and subject to availability of funds.

BACKGROUND:

This project includes the rehabilitation of the south half of the Daily Surface Lot at Jacksonville International Airport. The work will include asphalt milling; full depth pavement reconstruction of isolated areas; re-shaping and re-compacting existing lime rock base; 2" asphalt paving; and new parking lot signage and pavement markings. Existing curbs, utilities and storm drainage structures will be protected during construction.

The four bids shown in the table below were received through the DemandStar electronic bidding platform on July 20, 2021.

Duval Asphalt Products, Inc.	\$ 1,449,585.00
Hubbard Construction Company	\$ 1,712,072.50
Preferred Materials, Inc.	\$ 1,746,017.90
J. D. Hinson Company	\$ 1,949,698.33

Two of the four bidders, Duval and Preferred Materials, were found to be non-responsive due to their failure to: (i) meet the 10% SBE participation goal established for the project; and (ii) sufficiently demonstrate "good faith efforts" in an attempt to meet the goal. Hubbard Construction Company submitted the lowest responsive bid of \$1,712,072.50 which was approximately 7.5% below the Engineer's Estimate of \$1,854,725.00. A review of Hubbard's unit prices indicates that they are reasonable for the work to be performed.

There are currently \$1,830,565.00 remaining in the project budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends an award be made to Hubbard Construction Company, the lowest responsive, responsible bidder of four bidders in response to ITB C-862, for JIA Daily Surface Lot Rehabilitation, in the amount of \$1,712,072.50.
