

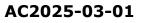

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Procurement Storeroom, in collaboration with JAA's Engineering & Facilities Department and General Aviation Airports, is responsible for maintaining airfield lighting parts. A large percentage of JAA's airfield lighting equipment is manufactured by ADB Airfield Solutions, which is Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved. As indicated by attached "Exhibit A," Procurement has identified Allen Enterprises as the sole source provider of ADB Airfield Solutions and related replacement parts.

Spend reports for the last three years indicate an average annual expenditure of approximately \$220,000.00. In order to maintain current inventory levels to support JAA's preventative maintenance programs and for outages due to inclement weather, JAA anticipates a future annual expenditure of \$230,000.00 over the next 5 years.

RECOMMENDATION:

Procurement recommends that JAA make a properly noticed award, pursuant to Section 3.09 of the Procurement Code, to Allen Enterprises, Inc., for FAA-approved ADB Airfield Lighting System and related replacement parts, in a total potential not-to-exceed award amount of \$1,150,000.00 over a five-year term.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) currently has 20 Jetway Passenger Boarding Bridges, commonly referred to as jetbridges, at the Jacksonville International Airport, with an anticipated six additional units for Concourse B. Jetbridges include, not only the Jetway Passenger Boarding Bridge unit, but also pre-conditioned air units, ground power units and Jetway water cabinets.

Procurement issued ITB No. 25-11-45123 on January 23, 2025 for Jetway Passenger Boarding Bridge Preventative Maintenance and Repair. On March 12, 2025, three conforming bids were received and JSM was the most responsive, responsible bidder.

In addition to preventative maintenance and repair costs, JAA's Engineering & Facilities Department also requests approval for annual repair parts costs in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for each year of the contract.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends an award be made to JSM Airport Services, LLC the lowest of three responsive, responsible bidders, for Jetway Passenger Boarding Bridge Preventative Maintenance and Repair Services, in a total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$10,031,098.00, based upon a term of three-years, with two annual renewal options. Funds for Jetbridge preventative maintenance and repair services are budgeted within cost center 45123.77280 and 77420.

BACKGROUND:

On February 26, 2024, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved JAA Award No. AC2024-02-04 to Williams Scotsman, Inc. for a modular office trailer lease and related costs for the Engineering & Facilities Electrical Shop until the completion of JIA Concourse B. Engineering & Facilities is satisfied with the office trailer and lease. On May 21, 2024, an amendment was executed for the delivery of a sanitation holding tank with weekly dump service. The requirement for the sanitation holding tank was an oversight when the initial lease was contemplated, and contingencies contained in the referenced award were not sufficient to address this issue.

Pursuant to Section 3.01(E) of the Procurement Code, the Director of Procurement has approved an increase of \$2,154.28 to partially address this overage; however, additional spend of \$74,461.00 is required through contract expiration of March 31, 2027.

RECOMMENDATION:

Procurement recommends properly noticed JAA Award No. AC2024-02-04, awarded to Williams Scotsman, Inc. for an Electrical Shop Mobile Office Lease, utilizing GSA Contract No. 47QSWA23D006P, be amended to: (i) ratify \$2,154,28 in accordance with Section 3.01 (E) of the Procurement Code; and (ii) increase the awarded funding by \$74,461.00 for use through contract expiration of March 31, 2027, resulting in a new potential total not-to-exceed amount of \$171,615.28. In December 2024, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) approved JAA Award No. AC2024-12-01 for Airline Supplemental Advertising to R&R Partners. As part of the air service incentive program, JAA endeavors to promote all new routes for the first two years of their operation. Allegiant Airlines will start flying nonstop from Jacksonville International Airport (JAX) to Akron/Canton, Des Moines and Grand Rapids.

These are new markets that gualify for the program. Allegiant's success on these routes means additional capacity at JAX, lower fares for the community and new nonstop markets.

Allegiant currently has a marketing relationship with R&R Partners, its advertising agency of record, a relationship from which JAA desires to benefit, particularly as it relates to continued and consistent advertising promotions and similar services relating to JAX. BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved JAA Award Nos. AC2021-09-04 and AC2023-05-03 to Ken Weeden & Associates, Inc. for ACDBE-DBE, Title VI and Community Participation Plan Consulting Services. Ken Weeden & Associates, Inc. has proven to be a valuable resource and was tasked with additional projects during FY24 that reduced approved funding, which additional projects included updates to DBE documents and the new small business element as mandated by the FAA.

Consequently, the referenced contract award requires additional funding of \$30,812.99 to complete FY25 contract services. The final contract renewal from October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026, is estimated at a not-to-exceed amount of \$36,578.00 pursuant to "Exhibit B."

BACKGROUND:

The Air Cargo 3 Apron Expansion project at Jacksonville International Airport (JIA) includes construction of approximately 11,600 SY of airfield concrete pavement; site grading; airfield lighting improvements; new high mast lighting; stormwater pond modifications; and other miscellaneous drainage improvements. The low bid submitted by Superior Construction Company, LLC is approximately 32 percent higher than the Engineer's estimate of \$4,680,425.00. This is primarily due to higher than estimated costs for the two concrete pavement items. However, the low bid is approximately 9 percent lower than the average of the next two low bidders, indicating that it is a reasonable price and reflects the current market conditions for the work included in this project. There is currently \$4,529,031.00 remaining in the project budget, so a budget transfer will be required for the award of the contract.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends an award to Superior Construction Company, LLC, the lowest responsive, responsible bidder of seven (7) bidders in response to ITB C-886, for the JIA Air Cargo 3 Apron Expansion Project, in the amount of \$6,183,445.00.
